1. Its source:

- Brigach and Breg brooks
- Furtwangen (1078m)
- Donaueschingen's Castle





- 3 parts:

- 1. Upper part:

- Germany 7%
- Austria 10%
- Slovakia 5.9%



Fast, it sinks the bed , and takes rocks

2. Middle part:

- Hungary 11.6% = 417km
- Croatia 4.4 %
- Serbia 10.2%

Slower



The 3. part is the mouth of the river

- Bulgaria 5.9%, Romania 29%, Ukraine 3.8%

 - Delta mouth

- It also has several **backwaters**.

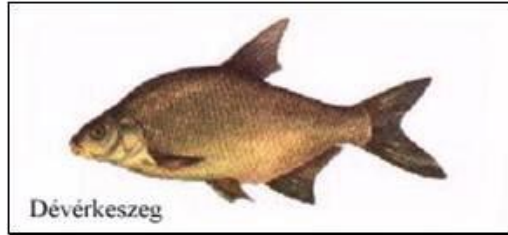
- It has 300 **tributaries**, the biggest one is Tisza. 30 of them is suitable for shipping.

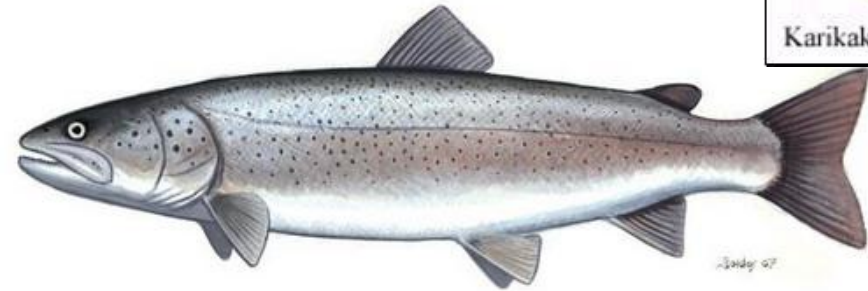

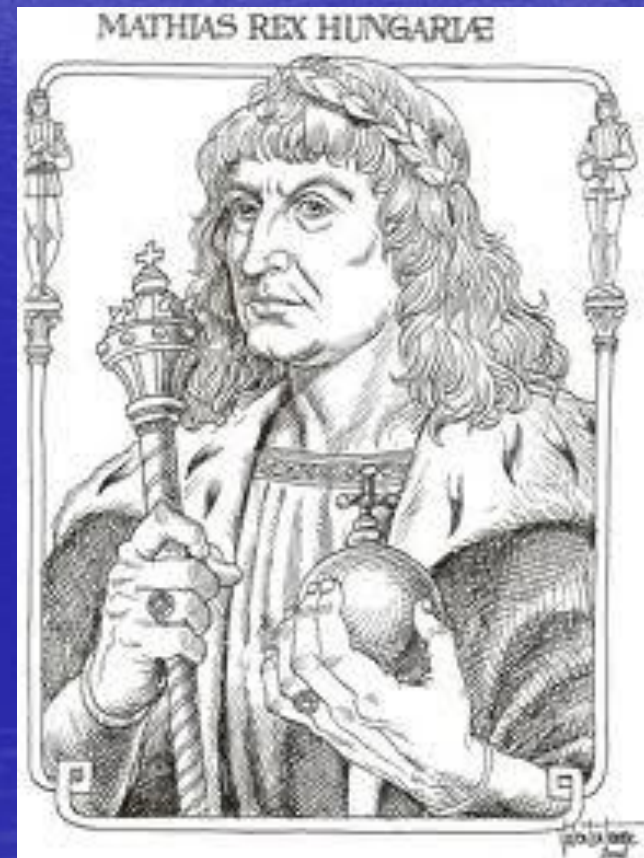
